DIRECTIONS

FROM PITTSBURGH:

Take the Parkway East to the Forest Hills exit 8a, Route 30. Follow Rt. 30 east through Forest Hills, across the Westinghouse Bridge, through North Versailles. At the intersection of Rt. 148 (Eckerd Drug, big gas station/mini mart) turn right. Follow Rt. 148 down the hill until it levels off and becomes Lysle Boulevard. You will pass through road construction near the entrance ramp to the Duquesne Bridge. Look for UPMC McKeesport Hospital on your left. Go 1 block past hospital and turn right into RIDC Park. The Maglev building will be on your left. There is another entrance to RIDC farther up Lysle Blvd. between the parking garage (closed) and the PAT bus center.

FROM MONROEVILLE:

Follow Route 48 south through North Versailles and White Oak past Olympia Shopping Center. When you can't go any farther, turn right onto Walnut Street (Daily News). Follow Walnut to Lysle Blvd. Make a right onto Lysle. At the parking garage (closed) and PAT bus center make a left into RIDC. Go past EchoStar to the Maglev building on the right.

FROM HARRISBURG:

Take the PA Turnpike (I-76) West to Exit 67 - Rt. 30/Irwin Exit. Take Rt. 30 west (Lincoln Highway) for about 9 miles or until you intersect with Route 148. Turn left onto Rt. 148 (5th Ave.) for 3.5 mi.. Rt. 148 will change into Lysle Blvd. Look for UPMC McKeesport Hospital on your left. Go 1 block past hospital and turn right onto Center Street. You are now in the RIDC Park. Once you are over the railroad tracks bear left. The second building on the left is MAGLEV, Inc's New 1905 Technology Center.
