TO APPLY:

1. Complete a Virginia Western Community College application. Apply for Program of Study #094. You may obtain an application at any of our locations, or apply online at: <https://apply.vccs.edu/app/app.htm>. Call Admissions at (540) 857-7231 for assistance.
2. Visit Virginia Western's Financial Aid office and complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid Form (FAFSA). Take your 2007 tax return with you to aid in answering FAFSA questions (applicants under age 24 may need additional parental information). Call (540) 857-7331 for details.
3. Write our screening committee a letter of no more than one page and explain why you should be accepted for this program. Be sure to include your full name, address, and student ID# or SSN in your letter. Send the letter to reach us before March 20, 2009 at:

If you are ready for a career change, or if you haven't yet selected a career path, consider VWCC's Intensive Welder Training Program.

Developed by and for area employers, this program includes college credit courses in math, blueprint reading, drafting and welding. Students will also complete an internship with a local company. The program is lab oriented, with small classes where students can obtain the help they need to be successful.

You will earn 16 college credits through Virginia Western Community College, and Financial Aid may be available to assist you with tuition and book costs of approximately \$1600 for the entire program. (This is the IN STATE tuition rate.)

In even numbered years, IWTP is held from 8am until 2pm. In odd numbered years, the program is held from 4pm until 10pm.
