We are excited to host a special program featuring speakers from Aerozone Alliance and TeamNEO. This program will highlight efforts to support the growth of aerospace and advanced manufacturing in Northeast Ohio. Speakers include Mary Schmidt, Director of Business Engagement at Aerozone Alliance; Keri Zipay, Director of Business Development for TeamNEO and Hrishue Mahalaha, Executive Director of Aerozone Alliance.

Mary and Keri will share insights from their Business Retention and Expansion (BRE) visits with local companies, focusing on opportunities to grow existing businesses and attract new ones to the region. They will also discuss resources like JobsOhio grants and workforce development initiatives. Hrishue will provide a high-level overview of Aerozone Alliance's mission to transform the 50-square-mile area around NASA Glenn Research Center and Cleveland Hopkins International Airport into a leading hub for aerospace innovation and economic development.

Aerozone Alliance is a nonprofit organization working to position Northeast Ohio as a leader in aerospace and advanced manufacturing. By fostering collaboration among businesses, academic institutions, and community partners, Aerozone Alliance drives innovation and supports economic growth.

TeamNEO is a key economic development organization for the region, dedicated to accelerating business growth and job creation. As part of the JobsOhio Network, TeamNEO connects businesses with resources, grants, and strategic partnerships to strengthen industries like manufacturing, aerospace, and defense.

AWS Scholarships

The Cleveland Section has three named scholarships, the **John Gerken**, the **Jack Buck**, and the **Ray Sacha**. Each of these awards has a specific focus. The **Gerken Award** helps pay for welding education at the community college and university level for up to four years. The student earning the **Buck Award** will receive a scholarship for learning pipe welding. The **Sacha Award** is to develop welding skills for students pursuing a post secondary degree in a welding related program and will assist with paying for hands on welding skills training. These scholarships are awarded to residents within the Cleveland Section boundaries -- Sandusky to Ashtabula, Cleveland to Akron. It is not necessary to be an AWS member or related to an AWS member to receive a scholarship.
