The Cleveland AWS section will be hosting a factory tour on **Tuesday, March 11th at 6:00 pm**. The tour will take place at Flextur located at 16875 Jericho Road, Dalton, Ohio 44618.

Flextur is a U.S. manufacturer specializing in welding and work cell solutions. A family-owned and operated company, Flextur designs and produces welding tables, welding fixtures, workbenches, material handling stations, and complementary solutions for cobot welding, such as docking stations and Quick-Change tables. Their products are built with a focus on LEAN principles, durability, and efficiency – helping businesses optimize workflow and maximize productivity. The evening will begin with an overview of Flextur's business history and manufacturing practices, followed by a guided facility tour. On the tour, attendees will see how Flextur products are manufactured. Some of the manufacturing steps include laser cutting, press brake operation, both manual and robotic welding, and painting.

The meeting / facility tour will start at 6 pm. Enjoy a classic Amish haystack dinner, a buildyour-own layered meal featuring a variety of fresh ingredients. And, of course, no meal would be complete without a local favorite - fry pies for dessert! There will be no cost for attending the meeting. Vic Matthews Grant

The Cleveland Section created a Vic Matthews Memorial Grant in 2024. The grant allows welding schools to buy welding equipment. Secondary and post secondary non-profit schools are eligible to apply for this \$10,000 grant. The money is to be used to further welding education. ATTENTION Welding Supervisors and CEOs

AWS will be offering 5 day Certified Welding Supervisor seminars in 2025. The location and dates of the seminars are listed below.

Welding supervisors can gain valuable credentials and add to knowledge needed to improve welders' productivity, throughput, weld quality, and safety. Participants learn the science of welding for better control of variables, as well as the economics of welding. The course, which helps attendees prepare to take the CWS certification exam (an option at a time and location of your choice) is taught from 8 AM to 5 PM at a welding related company site. The instructor is AWS Cleveland Section's Phil Schmidt, P.E., CWI, IWE.

AWS Scholarships

The Cleveland Section has three named scholarships, the **John Gerken**, the **Jack Buck**, and the **Ray Sacha**. Each of these awards has a specific focus. The **Gerken Award** helps pay for welding education at the community college and university level for up to four years. The student earning the **Buck Award** will receive a scholarship for learning pipe welding. The **Sacha Award** is to develop welding skills for students pursuing a post-secondary degree in a welding related program and will assist with paying for hands on welding skills training. These scholarships are awarded to residents within the Cleveland Section boundaries -- Sandusky to Ashtabula, Cleveland to Akron. It is not necessary to be an AWS member or related to an AWS member to receive a scholarship.
