To Speak on "Welding: Strength Through Diversity" at the AWS Columbus Section Meeting on March 13, 2025

The Talk: While the connection between diversity and welding may not seem obvious, Richard will describe how AWS plays a crucial role in fostering diversity connecting people from different backgrounds and disciplines to advance the science and technology of welding.
