The Tour: The evening will include a tour of a facility that produces 20-pound steel propane tanks, commonly used in backyard grills and other applications. The automated production line produces 4.2 million of these tanks each year. This facility also makes steel and aluminum tanks for forklifts and other uses. Please note that there are a limited number of persons that can be accommodated on this tour.

The Speaker: Welding Engineer Thomas Filbert will provide an overview of Worthington Enterprises and guide the tour.

Directions: The facility is located at 333 Maxtown Rd, Westerville, Ohio. Maxtown is an extension of Polaris Parkway past Route 3 in north Westerville. The sign at the entry says Worthington Industries Pressure Cylinder Division. Park anywhere in the yellow areas and enter the front of the building, circled in green (see map).

Special Instructions: No open-toed shoes are permitted on the tour. Steel-toed shoes are suggested but not required. Only those with safety shoes will be permitted to approach the equipment in operation. All others will be required to stay on painted walkways.
