In 2021, he was honored to have the opportunity to shift his career to focus on education, joining Northwest Florida State College as Assistant Professor for the Airframe and Powerplant programs. Christopher holds active FAA Airframe and Powerplant mechanic's ratings as well as a Remote Pilot rating. He is an Alumni of Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University with a Bachelor of Science in Aeronautics and a Master of Science in Aeronautics with a specialization in Aviation Safety.
