October Technical Meeting: Thursday October 9, 2025

Topic: Handheld Laser Welding & Collaborative Robots (Cobots)

Speaker: Nathan Moyer - CWI, CWS Airgas Great Lakes - TCL Level 1 Automation Sales Manager

Join us for a presentation by Nathan Moyer who will be sharing his insights on handheld laser welding and collaborative robotic welding. Handheld laser welding systems which allow for easier operation, reduced distortion, and faster production, even for less experienced welders, has made it a significant development for precision-focused industries like aerospace. This process requires detailed safety and training which needs to be understood and implemented.

Collaborative robots, or cobots, are robots designed to work safely alongside humans in shared workspaces, rather than being isolated by cages. They are ideal for repetitive, menial tasks like inspection, picking, and machine tending, allowing human workers to focus on complex, problem-solving tasks. Cobots offer advantages such as lower cost, flexibility, ease of programming, and energy efficiency compared to traditional industrial robots. A summary of applications, training requirements, and budgetary costs associated with both of these rapidly growing technologies will be discussed.

About the Speaker: Nathan Moyer is a seasoned professional with 26 years of experience in the industry. As a degreed welding engineer from The Ohio State University, Nathan brings a wealth of knowledge and expertise to the table. He has been a dedicated member of the American Welding Society for 29 years and serves on the AWS A5.32 Committee. During his time in industry, he has served the role of Weld Process Specialist and Automation Sales Manager for Airgas. Today, Nathan will be sharing his insights on handheld laser welding and collaborative robotic welding."

In addition to the presentation, a tour of CCAC Community Maker Lab will be offered. It is an industrial-level facility designed to support entrepreneurs and regional small businesses. It is available for low cost and offers equipment for advanced manufacturing, prototyping, and design.
